- Facility Use** Host an exclusive and private evening function for large groups and companies. Call (408) 298-5437 ext. 206 for more information.

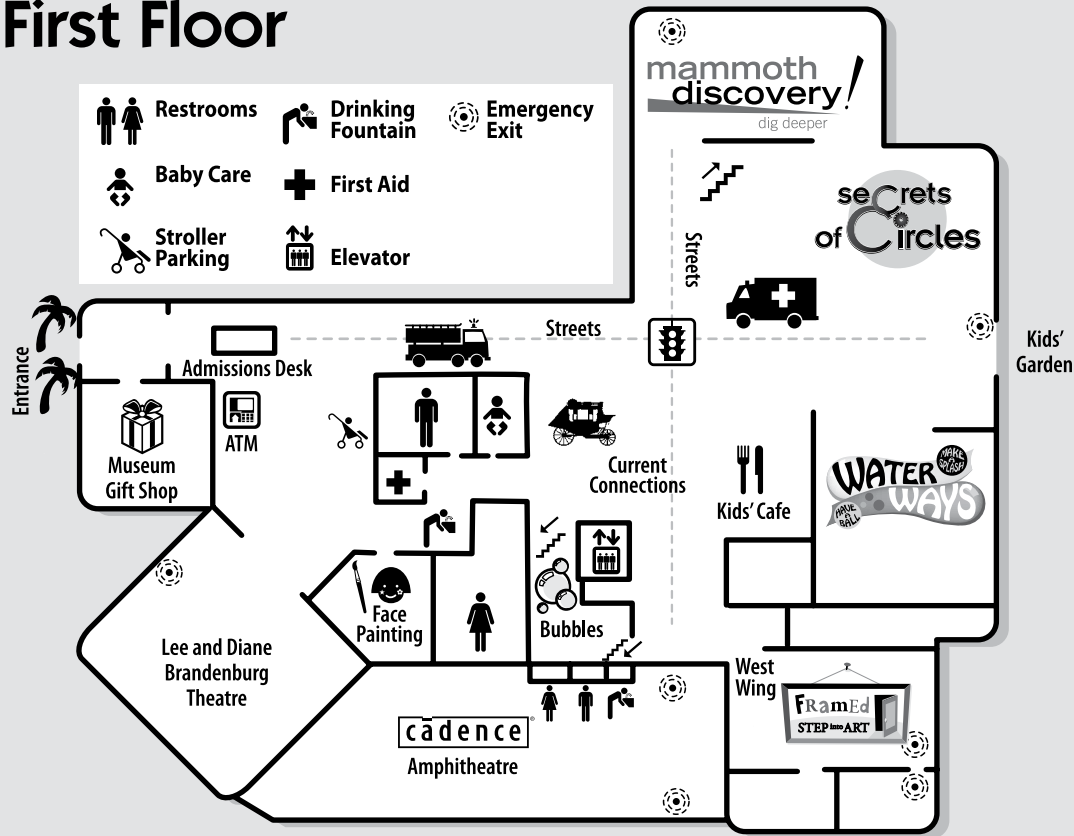

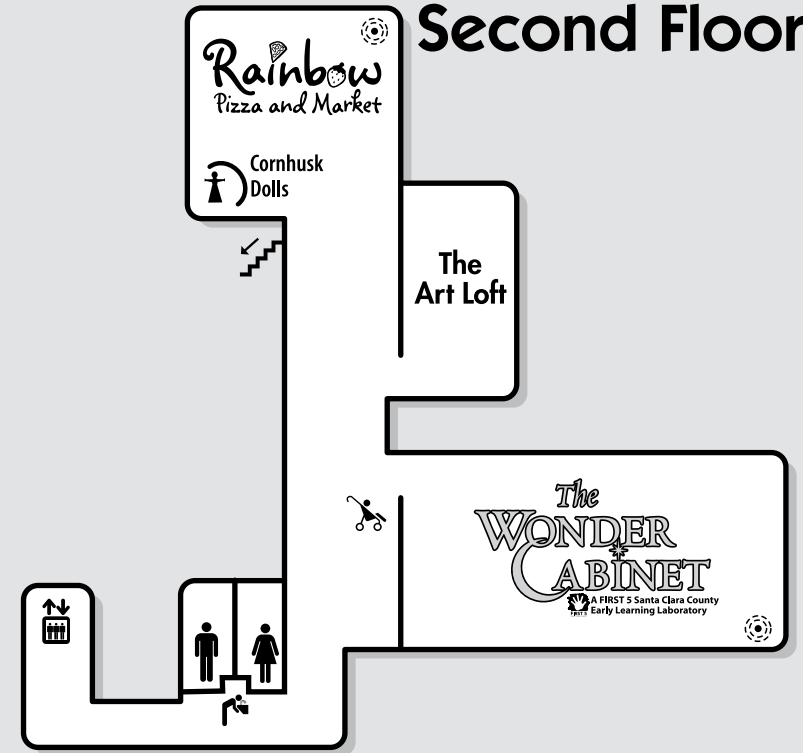

Permanent Exhibitions

Art Loft
